1. Be a citizen of the United States and a registered voter in Hernando County. (F.S. 102.012)
2. Be able to speak, read and write the English language clearly. (F.S. 102.012)
3. Attend a minimum of three hours of mandatory training, (F.S. 102.014)
4. Have a reliable source of transportation
5. Be available to work the entire time allotted to them on their scheduled day(s)
6. Have access to a computer and an email address
7. Have the ability to withstand long periods of continuous sitting or standing, the ability to lift 35 pounds, and be able to assemble and disassemble equipment
8. Be courteous, polite, able to work with the public and co-workers, and must have the ability to remain non-partisan throughout the day regardless of voter commentary or questions.

**As an Adopt-A-Precinct participant, you agree to provide volunteers who meet all of the above qualifications who will train and work at a voting location during an upcoming election and the volunteers provided will agree to donate the money earned to your group or organization.**
