Vote-by-Mail Ballots to be Mailed on July 14, 2020

Vote-by-Mail ballots will be sent out to 39,166 registered Hernando County voters on Tuesday, July 14, 2020 for the August 18th Primary Election.

Only those voters who have requested mail ballots will receive them in the first mail out. Additional requests can still be sent to the Supervisor of Election's website www.hernandovotes.com or by calling 352-754-4125. The deadline to request a mail ballot is Saturday, August 8, 2020 at 5 p.m.

Ballots must be returned via USPS or hand delivered to one of the Supervisor of Elections offices by 7 p.m. on Election Day. For those cutting it too close for traditional mail with the USPS, the ballots can be physically dropped off at either office.
